The Crick and think-cell have made think-cell software available to staff and students for academic and non-profit use.

think-cell is an add-in for Microsoft Office. It enhances chart creation in PowerPoint and Excel and allows you to quickly create complex charts, such as waterfalls and Gantt charts. think-cell can also be used to maintain a presentation's structure with auto-updating agendas, and to consistently round numbers in Excel sheets. The think-cell license key is valid for six months (*from date of installation*). When this has expired, you should follow **this link** for instructions on how to update the license key

think-cell offer their software FREE to academic or non-profit organisations, on the basis that the software is only used for education, public research or the core operations of nonprofit organisations. Administrative work with the software, such as in university hospitals, is not permitted. Students or staff who are no longer enrolled at or employed by The Crick or who intend to use the software for non-educational purposes must obtain a separate license.
